Heart of Ohio Family Health Offers COVID-19 Booster

COLUMBUS, Ohio — Heart of Ohio Family Health (HOFH) offers COVID-19 booster shots at HOFH at Capital Park (Tuesday, Wednesday, and Fridays), HOFH at Whitehall-Yearling High School (Thursdays) and HOFH at Canal Winchester (Mondays) locations.

For individuals who received a Pfizer, Moderna or Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot after their initial series:

- 18 years and older
- Were given a Moderna or Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine 6 months ago
- Were given a Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine at least 2 months ago

“I decided to get the COVID-19 booster as not just a teacher to protect my students but as a mom to protect my family,” said Etna Road Elementary School Fifth Grade Teacher, Lauren Marks. “I hope this booster helps us move towards getting back to a more normal life and school year.”

Individuals who receive a booster shot will benefit from additional protection. COVID-19 vaccines approved and authorized in the United States continue to be highly effective in reducing the risk of COVID-19. Vaccination remains the best way to protect yourself and reduce the spread of the virus and help prevent new variants from emerging.

“I decided to get the COVID-19 booster because I work directly with a lot of kids, parents and families throughout the school year during sporting events,” Whitehall-Yearling High School Athletic Director, Bill Hughett said. “I felt I should be better protected and ready for the indoor sports season while I interact with large crowds.”

HOFH will continue to offer COVID-19 vaccines at Heart of Ohio Family Health at Capital Park, Canal Winchester and Whitehall-Yearling High School locations. Doses of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine (a series of two doses administered 28 days apart) and the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine (one dose) are available. As a Federally Qualified Health Center, HOFH does not turn any patient away, regardless of their ability to pay. Anyone can make a vaccination appointment at HOFH by calling 614-235-5555.
